Bridging Histories: Exploring Transatlantic Slavery**

I hope this letter finds you well. The International Slavery Museum is closing so we are headed On Tour!

I'm thrilled to share an exciting opportunity for your Key Stage 3,4 and Sixth Form students to participate in our new outreach sessions with the International Slavery Museum.

Our On Tour Sessions offer an immersive exploration of transatlantic slavery, providing students with the tools to navigate and engage with this complex and challenging topic. Through two dynamic workshops, students will delve into the history of transatlantic slavery and examine how we approach and connect with this important legacy. Debate, discussion, and craft activities will encourage active engagement and reflection.

These workshops can either be held in your school or in one of community Learning Bases at LJMU, Wirral Met, or the Caribbean Center allowing students to immerse themselves in a higher education learning environment. This experience offers a valuable perspective on the local connections to transatlantic slavery and its legacies, enriching students' understanding of their community's history.

Sessions are £300 and run for 2 hours and 30 mins. The cost covers our operational equipment and our travel costs.

As a special offer for schools booking these sessions, we're delighted to provide a 50% discount of our Legacies of Transatlantic Slavery workshop at the International Slavery Museum which will be a great way to see our museum before we close at the end of the year. Additionally, the artwork created by students during the workshops will be featured in next year's Slavery Remembrance Day Programme providing a platform for their voices to be heard.
